

SFVA Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. 2021 Scholarship Guidelines

Who Are We?

DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC. is an organization founded at Howard University, Washington, D.C. in 1913 by a group of college women committed to serious endeavors and community service. Today, the organization is a public service sorority emphasizing scholarship, character, and community, national and international service. This scholarship is offered to provide some financial assistance and motivation to students as they pursue a higher education.

Who Can Apply?

- **HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS** who will be attending an approved accredited institution during the academic year immediately following the scholarship award (Fall 2021). Eligible institutions include four-year colleges or universities.
- Applicants must reside or attend high schools in the San Fernando Valley or Santa Clarita Area.
- Applicants must be young ladies of African Heritage.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above.

When & How Are Scholarships Awarded?

Scholarships are awarded on **Saturday, June 5, 2021** at our Virtual Scholarship Ceremony. All scholarship monies are paid directly to the recipient upon proof of enrollment, unless otherwise specified. The number of scholarships and their amounts are determined by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship awards will range from \$500 to \$1500 this year.

Scholarship awards will be distributed according to the following criteria:

- **Students who have demonstrated the following qualities through their application, essay, and recommendations:**
 - Good character and potential
 - Outstanding leadership abilities
 - Academic performance
- **Timely submission of completed application packet.**
- **Submission of an official sealed transcript.**

How Do I Apply?

Qualified students must complete a SFVA DST Scholarship Application and return it with the necessary supporting documents to the Scholarship Committee on or before the deadline listed on the application. Application materials may also be downloaded at www.sfvadeltas.org.

Who Evaluates the Scholarship Application?

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate all applications **postmarked** on or before the **May 15, 2021** deadline and award the number and amount of scholarships agreed upon by the Scholarship committee.

All applications and related material become the property of SFVA Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

Applications and information about applicants will be held in strict confidence by the Scholarship Committee.

The decision of SFVA DST Sorority, Inc. with regard to the scholarship award is **final** and not subject to appeal.

SFVA Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc **Scholarship Application Checklist**

The following documents must be mailed (no facsimile or email transmissions) to the Scholarship Committee, and must be postmarked (*stamped by teller*) by **May 15, 2021**:

1. **Completed and signed** SFVA Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. **Scholarship Application**.
2. **Personal Statement**, not to exceed 250 words, including additional information not included in the application.
3. A **typed essay** of one to two pages (double-spaced) adhering to the essay requirements on page 3 of the application packet.
4. **Two original signed letters of recommendation** from teachers, colleagues, or community leaders. These persons must have knowledge of your character, abilities, community service, leadership skills, achievements, or school or church-related activities.
5. Most recent official school **transcript, including cumulative GPA (sealed envelope)**.
6. A recent photograph of yourself.

NOTE: Each student is responsible for ensuring that a complete application packet is received by the SFVA DST Scholarship Committee by the deadline.

Personal Statement

This statement will explain why you deserve this scholarship and how you intend to use it. Explain any extenuating circumstances and insight that may not be reflected in the application thus far.

Essay Requirements

An essay double spaced, is required to complete your application. Be sure to include the question the title of your essay.

- ❖ What do you see is the most pressing issue facing African Americans today and how will you use your education to address it? Give specific examples.**
